I NEED YOU TO BE A SATERN OPERATOR!

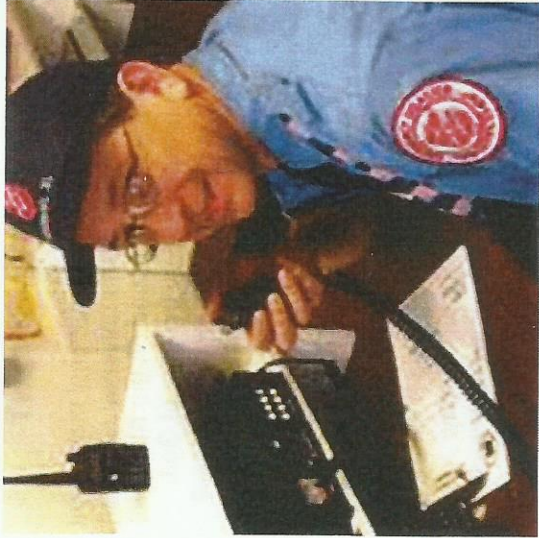
The Salvation Army needs dedicated, licensed Amateur Radio operators for **SATERN**.

SATERN operators typically,

- # Check into the International **SATERN** Net
- # Check into Regional/Local **SATERN** Nets
- # Provide emergency HF communications
- # Provide emergency VHF and UHF tactical communications
- # Coordinate The Salvation Army's Health & Welfare Inquiries out of a disaster area.
- # Advise The Salvation Army on a variety of communications and technical issues

Volunteers must be licensed Amateur Radio operators of any class. They must be in good general health with a willingness to behave in a professional manner under stressful conditions.
