Committee Reports

Repeaters – Howard Mitchell KD9WSV

Howard indicated that the power recycling units, targeted for installation at both of our repeaters, are complete thanks to the fine efforts of Oleg Harizanov, KD9ZZN, Mariusz Szpryngacz, AD9DU and Richard France, N9PAN. The first installation will be at the 2M small drive site (note, installation was successfully completed on 2/20).

New Business

Several discussions were raised:

1. Any update regarding location for summer field day? All options are still being evaluated but many potential sites are not adequate for our objectives. It is still hoped we can use the Schaumburg Plum Grove water tower site. Information is being prepared in response to the Village's recent request for information on our needs at that site. Another option that could be promising is the field behind St Peters's Church in Schaumburg. Brenda Fruhauf promised to discuss this possibility with the Pastor the week of 2/23.

An additional concern regards the storage of materials used for Field Day within the Pump House building at the 2M site. Schaumburg Public Works has indicated that they probably will not allow us to continue to have access which means we have to find some storage location for those materials. Any members that have suggestions for a storage facility are encouraged to contact one of the officers or a member of the Board.

2. There was a question raised regarding the growing membership and the ability accommodate members and their guests who wish to participate in the holiday party. The concern is that due to the limitation on how many can be accommodated at Pollyanna's, some members may feel they are not able to participate. There are challenges associated with finding a site that can accommodate us

without costing the club a significant amount of money. These concerns will be taken into account when planning for the 2027 party

3. A suggestion was discussed to keep track of how many students of our licensing classes actually take the exam, pass and then become members of the club.

4. Don Dewar noted that we have an opening for someone to run our fox hunt activity. At this time we no identified volunteers.
