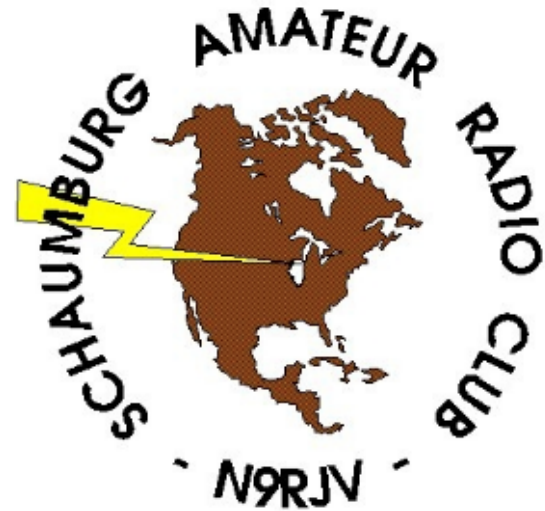




SCHAUMBURG AMATEUR RADIO CLUB
